COOKING OVER FIRE

Working so closely with the natural world, we like to cook over fire with wood from the farm, on our outdoor wood fired kitchen offering a theatrical centrepiece to your feast.

Our philosophy means that the emphasis is placed on food that is seasonal, sustainable, but most importantly - delicious! We have a strong connection with the local farmers and a deep knowledge of the wild lands of the West Country that surround us, often creating our dishes with food harvested or foraged wild both on and around the farm itself.







FEASTING

Specialising in locally and sustainably farmed, wild and foraged food, our style is ingredient led with a Mediterranean vibe. The outdoor kitchen is situated next to the main tepee, with the full spectacle and theatre on show to your guests.

We like to keep the dining style less formal these days - this usually involves a few delicious canapés with the drinks, followed by a plated starter or sharing boards, with some of our home cured charcuterie, smoked fish, terrines, pickles and ferments.

Main course would be some meat from either the farm itself or one of our very local suppliers, cooked over the wood fire and served feasting style with a few inspired salads on large platters down the tables - all topped off by a delicious pudding to power your guests onto the dance floor!





SPRING

Chalk stream trout ceviche, lime, coriander, chilli

Salt baked beetroot, labneh, lemon thyme pangratto

Buttermilk partridge, chipotle mayo

Charred asparagus, hawthorn, broad bean, buratta, anchovy, mint

Wood roast confit lamb shoulder, wild garlic salsa verde

Hedgerow greens, feta, lemon

Ember baked potatoes, nettle, burnt scallion butter

Gorse, primrose and rhubarb foragers mess

Evening street food:

Buttermilk chicken burgers; toasted brioche bun, buttermilk chicken, crispy iceberg, house slaw, pink pickles and mayo



SUMMER

White crab on toast, pickled sea purselane

Parmesan custard tart, confit tomato, pesto Trapanese

Spiced venison scotch quails egg, curry sauce

Torched day-boat mackerel, seaweed mayo, cured tomato, rock samphire

Charcoal grilled 40 day dry aged beef chops, rosemary, garlic

Borlotti bean, spelt, burnt tomato and rock samphire salad

Wilted sea beet, balsamic, pecorino

Sea buckthorn curd, Cheddar strawberries, meadowsweet ice cream

Evening street food:

Wood roast chicken, chorizo and cold water prawn paella



AUTUMN

Pheasant goujon, truffle, parmesan

Crispy hake, lemon caper mayo

Roe deer bombette Pugliese

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Cedar planked duck, slow roast beet, pumpkin seed crumb, autumn
raspberry and elderflower dressing

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Tuscan style wood roast porchetta, smoked quince aioli

Fennel, apple, watercress, hazelnut dressing

Ember roast squash, toasted barley, wild sorrel

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Mascarpone mousse, heather honey, charred oats, wild blackberries
and pear, pine nuts

Evening street food:

Autumn truffle Mac 'n' Cheese, smoked lardon crumb



WINTER

Salt cod beignet, smoked tomato reduction

Oxtail croquette, gremolata

Butter braised burnt carrot, parsley yoghurt

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Moroccan spiced charcoal grilled monkfish, smoked hummus,
pomegranate dressing, zaatar

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Apple brined wood roast chicken, smoked apple mayo

Truffled celeriac gratin, chicken fat crumb

Hasselback potatoes, winter greens, seaweed butter

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Treacle tart, whisky ice cream, caramelised walnut crumb

Evening street food:

Slow smoked brisket flatbreads, horseradish remoulade, salsa verde



WHEN THE PARTY IS OVER

We have three luxury self-catered cottages on the farm, so when the party is over you can collapse into an incredibly comfortable bed, just a stones throw away.

The Haybarn, a Victorian style barn conversion, sleeps two people and is positioned across the courtyard from the main farmhouse. The cottage makes a lovely romantic hideaway and with it's own indoor pool, can you think of anywhere better to spend your wedding night? The Lamb which also sleeps two, has a large flagstone floor and a gorgeous open fireplace. It offers far reaching views across the Somerset countryside. The woodfired hot tub is the perfect place to relax after a busy day of wedding planning.

The Fleece, our largest cottage, is incredibly spacious and can sleep up to eight people. Downstairs there is a large open plan kitchen living area with an AGA, large table and plenty of storage space. There is a lovely sunroom which really traps the warmth of the sun and a large sitting room which is the perfect place for bridesmaids to get ready. There is one king sized bedroom downstairs and three additional bedrooms upstairs. One of these is a twin. There is also another king and a super king which can be made up as a twin if preferred.





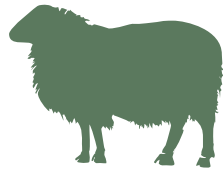


SLEEPING UNDER THE STARS

Our safari tent offers six of your guests the chance to glamp in its most glamorous form. With a fully equipped kitchen, bathroom, shower, sitting area and wood burning stove, as well as incredible views, what's not to like!

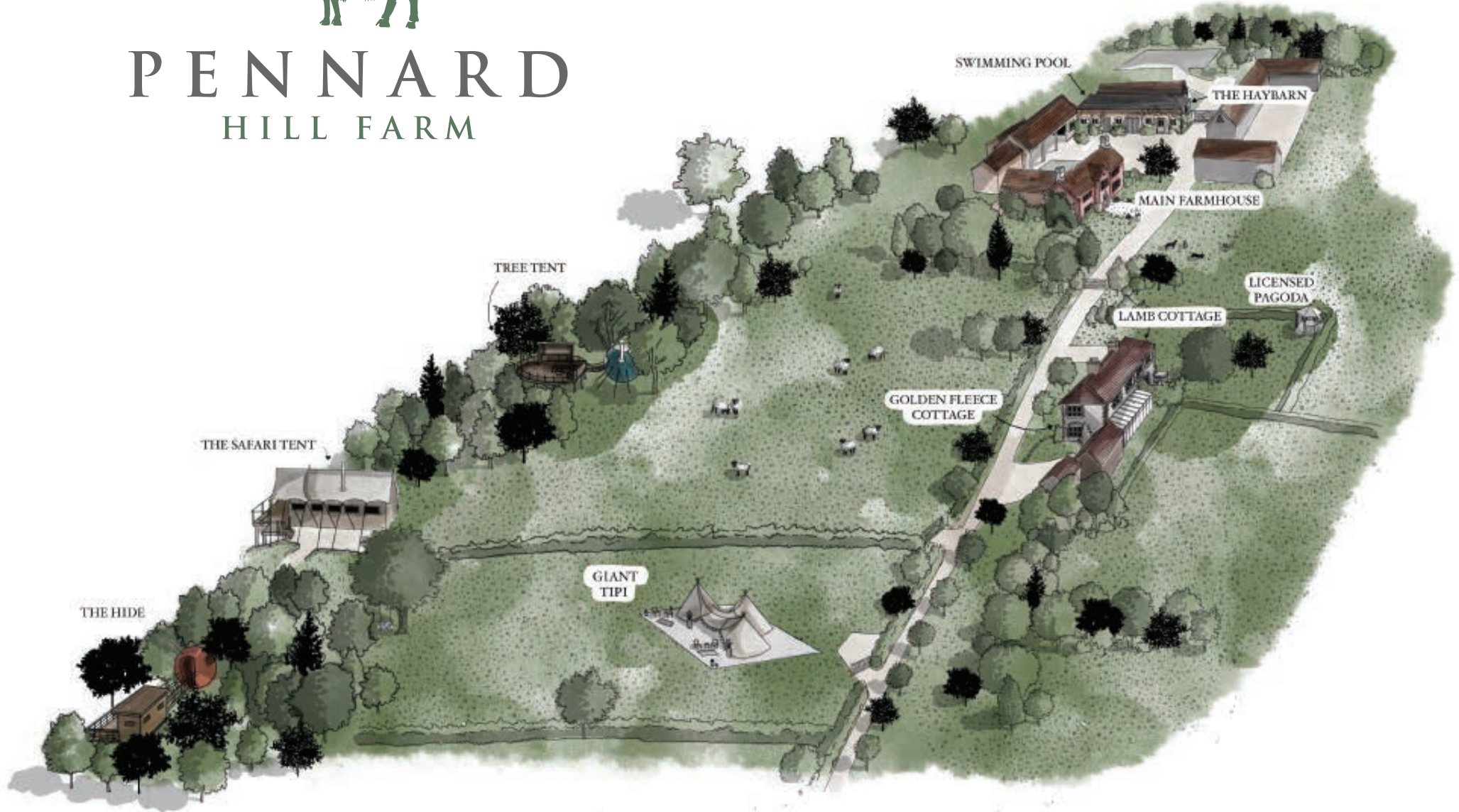
The Tree Tent is a suspended spherical structure strung between two trees overlooking the gorgeous Mendip Hills. It offers the ultimate escape into the outdoors. It's an absolutely magical retreat which captures the true romance and cosiness of camping but in a luxurious and unique way. The Tree Tent has a comfortable double bed, solar powered LED lighting and a wood burning stove, perfect for those chilly evenings. The bed even folds into a sofa for daytime lounging! The Tree Tent sleeps two people and The Hide, our latest addition to the farm, sleeps four people.

If you are looking for additional accommodation, we have 14 of our own yurts which can sleep up to four people and 14 belle tents sleeping two in each. These both come fully equipped with proper beds, mattresses, pillows, fresh white sheets, and fluffy towels. Everything you should need for a great nights sleep.



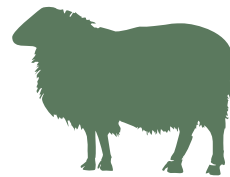
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
